



# Brownie Days at the Birthplace

"Brownie Day" is a Birthplace visit designed especially for Girl Scout Brownies. The events each include different songs, games, crafts and a special Brownie house activity related to the theme of the event in Daisy's own home (instead of a formal house tour). They will earn a Brownie Day Patch and arches that circle the patch. Brownies also work on a Try-It and learn about a different part of Daisy Low's life during each session. Girl Scout Brownie may choose to come in uniform, or may choose to make simple costumes using guidelines provided by the Birthplace. The sessions compliment each other and give Brownie troops several visits to the Birthplace. The program lasts about one hour, but with check-in and shopping, plan to be at the Birthplace for 1 ½ - 2 hours.

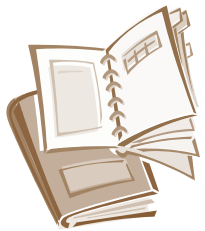


## Brownie Girl Scouts the World O'er

Enter into the history of Girl Scouts from the early days. Experience activities girls loved to do in 1912. Investigate worldwide Brownies. Explore the heritage and history of Girl Scouting and learn the traditional Girl Scout ways. Learn about the Founder and why she loved Girl Scouting! Girls work on the "Playing around the World" Try-It. **February 12, 2011. Registration Deadline: January 2, 2011.**

## Juliette "Daisy" Low's Days-Victorian Childhood

Recreate the everyday fun of a little girl in Daisy's times. Learn how to act, play and make things like Juliette Gordon Low did as a child! Brownies will become Daisy's playmates and cousins, doing all the things she enjoyed the most. This event features May Day fun and Mother's Day giftmaking. Girls work on the "Daisy's Neighborhood", Savannah Council's Own Try-It. **May 7, 2011, Registration deadline May 1, 2011**



## Old Fashioned School Days

This event focuses on Juliette Gordon Low's experiences in school. Brownies will pretend they are students from the past. Explore Daisy's letters home from school and make an old-fashioned slate board. Discover what Juliette Low thought about school as a child. This event features stories, games, and the completion of a craft. Girls work on the "Her Story" Try-It. **September 25 and 26, 2010. Registration Deadline: August 29, 2010.**

## Christmas 1886 with the Gordons

This event includes festive family holiday fun. Participants will meet costumed characters from Daisy's life, who help them celebrate the holidays in her house with traditional songs and stories. After playing the part of the Gordon children in the beautifully decorated family home, Brownies make a special Victorian craft to share with their families when they return home. Start the holiday season off with a visit to the past! Girls work on the "Listening to the Past" Try-It. **December 4.5, & 11, 2010. Registration Deadline: November 1, 2010.**



## Cost

There is a **\$25.00 non-refundable reservation fee** for each troop. You may register your troop for up to four sessions of Brownie Day at one time for one reservation fee. The program fee is \$5.50 per participant. Two Girl Scout leaders must participate with their troop. The fee includes the cost for all materials, activities, and a Brownie Day patch for each person. "Second Time Around" and "Third Time's the Charm" patch arches are given for girls who attend multiple events. *Extra adults may opt to take a formal tour of the historic house during the Brownies' program.*

## Registration Procedures

1. Call the Birthplace at (912) 233-4501 and make a tentative reservation.
2. After you have made a reservation, fill in the registration form. Get permission from your Girl Scout Council office to travel.
3. Send this completed form with your \$25.00 reservation fee within 14 days of your call. You may register for four sessions of Brownie Days at a time for one reservation fee. This will confirm your reservation. *Fees may be paid with a credit card, money order, certified bank check or council check.*
4. After you send or bring in your registration, you will receive a confirmation, and a reconfirmation form to return to us three months prior to your visit with your full fees.
5. All participants' fees (\$5.50 per person) are due one month prior to your visit.
6. Please call to register any additional girls or adults. Fees are non-refundable. Please pay for only confirmed participants.
